Subject: Inviting of bids for disposal of old condemned Car of the Ministry of Textiles.

Sir,

The Ministry of Textiles intends to dispose of old condemned Car. The details of the Car are as given below:-

- i) Registration No:DL 2CQ-2027.**
- ii) Make:-2007.**

2. In case you wish, you may submit your bids for the above mentioned car along with a demand draft of Rs.15000/- (Rupees fifteen thousand only) as earnest money drawn in favour of DDO, Ministry of Textiles latest by 02.03.2016 by 3.00 PM in a sealed cover addressed to the Under Secretary(Admn.), Ministry of Textiles, Room No.29-B, UdyogBhavan, New Delhi-11. The interested parties may contact Shri Ashutosh Kr. Jha, Section Officer, Room No.29-B, UdyogBhavan, New Delhi for inspection of the car on all working days up to 26.02.2016 between 3.00 PM to 4.00 PM.

3. The bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders on 02.03.2016 at 3.15 PM in Room No.29-B, UdyogBhavan, New Delhi. The bidder will be selected on the basis of the highest bid. The successful bidder will be required to deposit the money in cash or submit a demand draft in favour of the DDO, Ministry of Textiles within a period of three working days from the date of letter of the Ministry asking for the same.

4. The successful bidder will remove the sold car within two days of depositing the money. Thereafter, this Ministry will not be responsible for the safety of the car.

5. Registration certificate in case of firms and residence proof in case of individuals or any other document as asked for by the Ministry as proof of identity shall have to be provided by the bidders.

6. The successful bidder will have to get the car transferred in his name within 45 days from the date of taking physical possession of the car. An Affidavit in this regard will have to be given, duly attested by Notary, before taking possession of the car.

7. In case the car is not intended to be put to use, it will be presumed that it will be scrapped. In such a case an affidavit to this effect from the Notary will have to be given before taking possession of the car.

8. The Ministry reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the bids without assigning any reason.
