

Selection of Sites/ Park

Challenge Method to select the sites

18 proposals for PM MITRA parks were received from 13 States. Eligible States and sites were evaluated using a Challenge Method based on objective criteria taking into account a variety of factors such as connectivity, existing ecosystem, textile/industry policy, infrastructure, utility services etc. Gati Shakti tool was also used for validation.

The following 7 States/sites have been found to be the best suited for setting up Mega Textile Parks under the PM MITRA scheme:

- 1 Tamil Nadu (Virudhunagar)**
- 2 Telangana (Warangal)**
- 3 Gujarat (Navsari)**
- 4 Karnataka (Kalaburagi)**
- 5 Madhya Pradesh (Dhar)**
- 6 Uttar Pradesh (Lucknow)**
- 7 Maharashtra (Amravati)**
